# SUSAN T. RODRIGUEZ FAIA

Susan Rodriguez began an independent practice in 2017, combining more than thirty years of design leadership in the public realm with her passionate belief in the power of architecture to affect change and improve the quality of life for all. Ms. Rodriguez is known for excellence in the design of buildings for cultural, educational, scientific and governmental institutions. She is the recipient of the 2016 Design Leader Award from Architectural Record for the for the breadth and impact of her built work over the last three decades. She has also received numerous awards for design excellence, among them, National AlA Honor Awards, New York State AlA Awards, New York City AlA Awards and American Architecture Awards from the Chicago Athenaeum, as well as many regional awards. Prior to creating her own firm, she was a founding Partner and Design Principal in Ennead Architects (formerly Polshek Partnership) recipient of the NYC AlA 2012 Medal of Honor and the Cooper Hewitt National Design Award in Architecture.

Ms. Rodriguez's work focuses upon the essential integration of exterior and interior space and the vital unity of site and program. Whether rural landscape or dense urban context, she seeks to create an architecture that is fused with its surroundings and the natural world. Her design process explores the use of innovative materials, technologies and systems to activate powerful formmaking. Underscoring the significance of the environment and architecture's role in its preservation, her designs are models for the application of sustainable design strategies.

As an extension of her professional work, Ms. Rodriguez actively promotes the importance of design in the public realm, having been a long-term board member of the Architectural League of New York and founding board member of Art Works Projects: Art + Design for Human Rights. She lectures frequently on her work and has taught numerous design studios at Cornell, Columbia and City College. Ms. Rodriguez received a Bachelor of Architecture degree from Cornell University's College of Architecture, Art and Planning, where she serves as the co-chair of the Dean's Advisory Council and was a member of the University's Board of Trustees. She received a Masters degree from Columbia University's Graduate School of Architecture, Planning, and Preservation.
